## Fees

The fees for the orchestra are as follows:

1 child = \$50 per term. (\$200 for the year) 2 children = \$75 per term. (\$300 for the year)

Fees should be paid at the start of each term or for the full year. It is best to pay fees online with internet banking, then I have an accurate record of who has paid for what. This year for the first time in about 5 years we have had to increase our fees for the orchestra. This is because the cost of hiring the church hall on a Wednesday afternoon has been significantly increased. We still feel it is the best place for us at the moment, but are actively looking for other venues to rehearse at. If anyone can help with this, please email me and let me know.

#### Music

You have 3 or 4 pieces of music currently, and this will increase to about 7 or 8. We will be playing the music you have at our concert in June and then on our Tour in Aug, then you will hand all this music in. In mid Term 3 we will be starting new music for the end of year concerts.

# Camp

Each year we go away together as an orchestra to one of the local camps for a night so that we can get to know each other a bit better, and have the chance to rehearse and practice the pieces we are playing. This year the camp will be on the weekend of the 7th, 8th of May. Please keep this weekend free as camp is a compulsory part of the orchestra. We will be staying overnight Saturday 7th, and coming home on Sunday 8th at around 1.30pm. Please keep this in mind if you have other commitments on a Sunday morning you will need to miss these to come on camp.

## Concert

Our main concert each year happens at the end of Term 2. This year the concert will be at the Bruce Mason Centre on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June. We will be having a dress rehearsal during the afternoon after school, with the concert at this stage scheduled for 6.30pm. More details to follow.

# Stringalongs

If you are a string player and especially those in violin 3 and 2 and cellos, you are welcome to also play in the Stringalongs. This is our training string orchestra, and will give you a chance to learn some more of the skills required to progress up through the orchestra sections. Because the Junior Orchestra is so large now, our rehearsals can often blast through some of the more specific string techniques, so time in Stringalongs will help you to learn these better.
